Speaking of animals, I had a chance to see one of the more magnificent sights in these here parts. I was driving west from Drain to Reedsport wondering if I would see any elk by the BLM's Dean Creek Elk Viewing Area. The first thing I came across after passing Dean Creek was a herd of 18 bull Roosevelt elk meandering easterly through the field. Many of them were up against the fence within easy photo range no doubt aware of their protected status. There were a couple of seven point bucks in the group. Needless to say, many of the people passing alongside this herd brought their cars and trucks to a screeching halt for a better look. About a mile west of the boys was a herd of over 100 cows and calves.

The Port Orford Chamber of Commerce held its annual membership dinner this past Monday evening at the Truculent Oyster restaurant. Chamber vice president Al Affonso introduced all the officers and board members. He also introduced Charles Qullen who was chosen citizen

Last week I was going to congratulate Senator Bill Bradbury for being elected Senate Majority Leader. What a difference a week makes. Since he attained this high and mighty post he appointed Senator Peg Jolin as Chairman of the Business, Housing and Consumer Affairs Committee. Ms. Jolin was convicted in November of several felonies in connection with a fundraising letter she sent out soliciting donations to pay off a campaign deficit when the truth was she had a surplus of funds. This is a bad mistake on the part of Senator Bradbury, who represents the south coast. Jolin provided one of the key votes for Bradbury in breaking the deadlocked Senate in picking their new majority leader. Her felony convictions are on appeal. Instead of congratulating Bill let's say I'm disappointed. I have called his office in Salem and let them know my opinion. There is a recent precedent by which we can judge his action: When former county commissioner David Werschkul, was convicted of a felony his office was quickly vacated even though his conviction was on appeal. As the saying goes it's who you know...

Gregg Fix, booking agent for the Circus, will visit Port Orford in late February or early March to meet with the Chamber of Commerce and arrange details. Plan to see Barbara the Elephant.

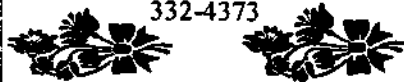

### Stop! Don't turn that knob!

Most dot-matrix printers have a large, convenient knob on the side of the printer. Turning the knob moves the paper up or down in the printer. This knob should only be used when power is OFF! Turning the knob with power on will strip the gears on many printer models! It is also recommended that you only use it to run the paper forward and not backward. Feeding paper backward can cause jams and, in extreme cases, damage to the printer.

All of these printers have line-feed and form-feed buttons which may be used to move paper forward. Many also have a

## Fingernails & Your Health

Conclusion of a 3-week Information Column

This is the third and final listing of nail disorders that may give clues to your health.

**Terry's Nails:** Nail looks opaque and white, but the nail tip has a dark pink to brown band. May accompany cirrhosis, congestive heart failure, adult onset diabetes, cancer or aging.

**Vertical ridges:** Narrow ridges that run the length of the nails. May appear in adulthood and become more obvious with age. Also may accompany kidney failure.

**Yellow-nail syndrome:** One or more nails turn yellow or green. Nails grow more slowly and the cuticle and "moon" disappears. May be associated with swelling of the hands and feet, or a variety of respiratory diseases.

Remember, nail problems are just clues. Never attempt self diagnosis; leave this to your physician.

If you only suffer from weak nails, there are ways to toughen them up. File your

nails fairly short and in a square-round shape. Apply a professional nail hardener, but avoid products with toluene sulfonamide/formaldehyde which can cause itchiness, redness and irritation.

Apply moisturizer each time you wash your hands and before bed. Don't forget to rub into the cuticles. Wear cotton-lined gloves when exposing hands to household chemicals or water.

Instead of removing polish every time it's chipped, try touching it up. Overuse of polish remover, especially that with acetone can dry your cuticles and nails.

Contrary to many beliefs, gelatin will not strengthen your nails.

Remember, see your doctor if you really suspect a health problem.

at the top margin, ready for printing), and tear position (paper moved up so the perforations are aligned with a plastic guide so you can easily tear off your printout.) Your printer manual (and a few

minutes of playing with the controls) will make you an expert on the use of these buttons. Don't be penny-wise and pound-foolish. Paper costs less than a penny a page. Go ahead, splurge and waste a nickle's worth or two while you train yourself to use the buttons!

Laser printers don't have these knobs but do have a very important limitation. Never use a mechanical switch to share a laser printer between two or more computers - mechanical switches can short circuit the printer's electronics and cause a *very* expensive failure. If you want to share your laser printer, use an electronic switch which is automatic, hence more convenient, and which does not use mechanical contacts.

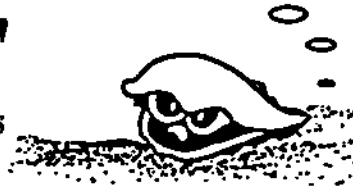
