Search and Rescue by Evan Kramer

The Curry County Sheriff's Search and Rescue are presenting the Marcy Brothers in a benefit concert this Saturday evening, February 6. The music takes place in the indoor arena-pavilion at the Curry County Fairgrounds in Gold Beach. The performance starts with an opening act at 7:30 pm. The Marcy Brothers are a country music band whose songs, including a version of *Achy Breaky Heart* can be heard on Gold Beach radio station KGBR.

Curry County Deputy Larry Adcock is the coordinator of the Search & Rescue. He says he wants to sell out this concert and prove that big concerts can be held in Curry County. The tickets for this concert are \$12 at the door but are available for \$10 if you purchase them in advance. Tickets are available at the Chetco Credit Union in Port Orford and in Gold Beach at the Gold Beach Floral and Record Rack and the Jumpback Deli. They are also being sold at the Escape Hatch Sports and Cycle Shop in Brookings.

Deputy Adcock says there are anywhere from 12 to 18 incidents a year in Curry County where the Search and Rescue team is called in for help. This is a rugged, mountainous county with a long coastline and an abundance of rivers - it's fortunate they're not busy all the time. Besides the inaccessibility of many parts of the county hikers, hunters and fishermen are faced with a lack of good, well marked trails. It's easy to get lost, just ask me.

In addition to Deputy Adcock, the Search and Rescue is made up of volunteers who pay for their uniforms and equipment with their own money and donate their time. This benefit concert will help pay for more of the equipment they need to rescue people who have fallen down a mountainside or been swept away by the strong currents of a river. The Search and Rescue puts on a display every year at the Curry County Fair where you can see their van and equipment and meet many of the fine volunteers.

It happened. Punxsutawney Phil from Punxsutawney, PA came out of the ground on Tuesday, saw his shadow and went back down into his burrow. So it was reported on the ABC radio network. Later on that same day Ewald Stollger from Ophir dropped by the store and told me he saw television coverage of the groundhog's activities. If you believe in this stuff you'll refrain from planting your crops since there will be six more weeks of winter weather. Here in Port Orford we're having some of the best weather of the year. Sunny, warm and without the summer winds, although all that can change faster than Phil can spot his shadow and disappear down his hole.

The American Legion is holding a breakfast this Sunday morning at the American Legion Hall in Port Orford. I know they'll appreciate a good showing from local residents who can fill up on bacon and eggs and get a good start on the day.

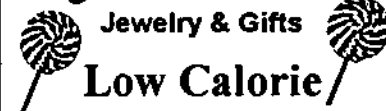

Safety, Survival Training for Commercial Fishermen

Marine Safety Training classes are now available to Oregon commercial fishermen in their home ports. This has been made possible through a cooperative effort involving coastal community colleges under the guidance of the Maritime Science Program at Clatsop Community College in Astoria and the U.S. Coast Guard. Program development funds have been provided by the Oregon State University Sea Grant.

The class provides practical training in sea survival, covers first aid, CPR, emergency preparation, cold water near drowning, hypothermia, survival in cold water, marine fire fighting, vessel stability, emergency procedures, safety equipment, federal regulations, and Coast Guard rescue. Tuition for the 40 hour class is \$195.00.

Federal Regulations

New Federal regulations require that monthly safety drills be conducted on board your vessel. Further, after September 1, 1993, a fishing vessel with more than two people on board must have one person trained in both first aid and CPR. After September 1, 1994, at least one person on each vessel must be properly

trained to conduct monthly safety drills and instruction.

The course is Coast Guard approved and anyone who satisfactorily completes the 5 day Marine Safety Training may be credited with the equivalent of 25 days of deck service on vessels of not more than 200 gross tons.

Classes are scheduled in Coos Bay from February 8-12 and March 8-12. A class is scheduled for Brookings from March 15-19. For more information contact Curry County ESD in Gold Beach at 247-2741 or Southwestern Oregon Community College in Coos Bay at 888-2525.

Stories of Faraway Places

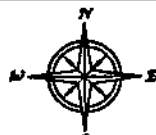

If you live in a big city, you have a choice of dozens or hundreds of computer bulletin boards (BBS). Using a modem, your computer can make a connection thru your existing telephone lines to these other computers and send electronic mail (email) to other computer users, exchange computer software, share ideas and conversations with others, etc.

The south coast, unfortunately, has a shortage of such bulletin boards. The closest public board is in Coos Bay. This is a shame because a good system could provide many benefits. It could bring the communities closer by encouraging communications between residents of each

area. It could promote the area to potential tourists from around the world. It could provide various informational assistance to people, and, I have to admit, BBS's are just plain fun!

I am planning to set up a BBS at the Fun Zone and hope to have it operational sometime in March or April. I want to link it with other BBS systems, probably joining the 14,000+ worldwide Fidonet system.

If we can get other systems established in Brookings, Gold Beach, and Bandon, we can link them all together in such a way that mail can be inexpensively sent from one end of the South Coast to the other!

To make this all happen, we need a computer system in each town. Each computer needs a modem, software and a phone line. Each system needs a sysop (a SYSTEM OPERATOR - a computer literate person who can set up the software, answer mail, delete old messages, post bulletins, and generally act as a moderator and janitor for the system.) Meanwhile keep watching here for news of our upcoming BBS. Late news: looks like we have a system for Bandon users! More later...
