Think Globally, Shop Locally by Evan Kramer

Now that the Port Orford-Langlois teachers and the school board have both accepted the factfinder's report the ongoing big story is the continued closure of Highway 101. Many locals and others in the know have been using a Forest Service alternative to get Gold Beach, back and beyond. It consists of going up Elk River Road (5325) to Forest Service road 5502 to Euchre Creek Road (3402) which brings you back to Highway 101 in Ophir. The detour is being widely used and, in too many cases, abused. The 20 miles of 5502 and 3402 that are gravel road are wide enough in most spots for two cars to pass (carefully and slowly) but there are many sharp turns with low visibility. People using this bypass need to cooperate with each other and drive safely. The Forest Service asks that motorists who use the detour turn their headlights on and Go Slow.

Now for an update as of Tuesday morning, March 30, on the situation at the Highway 101 landslide. The Oregon Department of Transportation estimates it will have a temporary road open 7 - 10 days from now. The temporary road will be built upon the slide area and consist of a bed of wood

chips topped off with gravel. The wood chips will start arriving as of March 30. The temporary road will have two lanes. ODOT says the slide has stabilized but that weather, particularly whether or not there are more heavy rains, will determine whether the temporary road is opened next week. Heavy rains could cause further movement by the mass of serpentine on which the road is built. ODOT estimates it will take 1-2 construction seasons to build a more permanent solution. Now that the wood chips and heavy equipment are converging on the landslide ODOT asks that people stay away from the site for everyone's safety.

The coastal towns of Brookings, Gold Beach, Port Orford and Bandon have seen a dramatic drop in traffic as the Oregon Department of Transportation and Caltrans encourage motorists to use Interstate 5. South of Coos Bay are two ODOT signs urging use of Highway 42 to 5 and in California northbound motorists are being urged to take Hwy 199 to I-5.

Locally businesses are feeling the effects of the highway closure. Every business owner I've spoken to, including Rick Cook, Butch Ramey, Linda Culbertson,

Gayle Wilcox and Gwendolyn Guerin among others, has told me about the drop in their trade. Restaurants, motels, galleries, markets, gas stations, etc. all draw heavily from the traffic that normally passes through Port Orford and Gold Beach on any given day.

One thing that could help this situation is for all of us to make a conscious decision to *shop locally* as much as we possibly can. The many affected businesses need our help right now. The small business owners along the coast are in many ways the heart and soul of our communities. Most of us take their existence for granted. We assume they'll open on a regular basis and always be there for us. We don't realize the difficulties they endure especially in winter when tourist traffic is normally down. Highway 101 closed last week just a few days into Spring Break disrupting what should have been a busy week.

There's plenty of things for people to do around here from surfing, bicycling, and hiking to whale watching. The art galleries have some interesting things going on. Who knows with all the peace and quiet it might be time to visit Port Orford and write the Great American Novel.

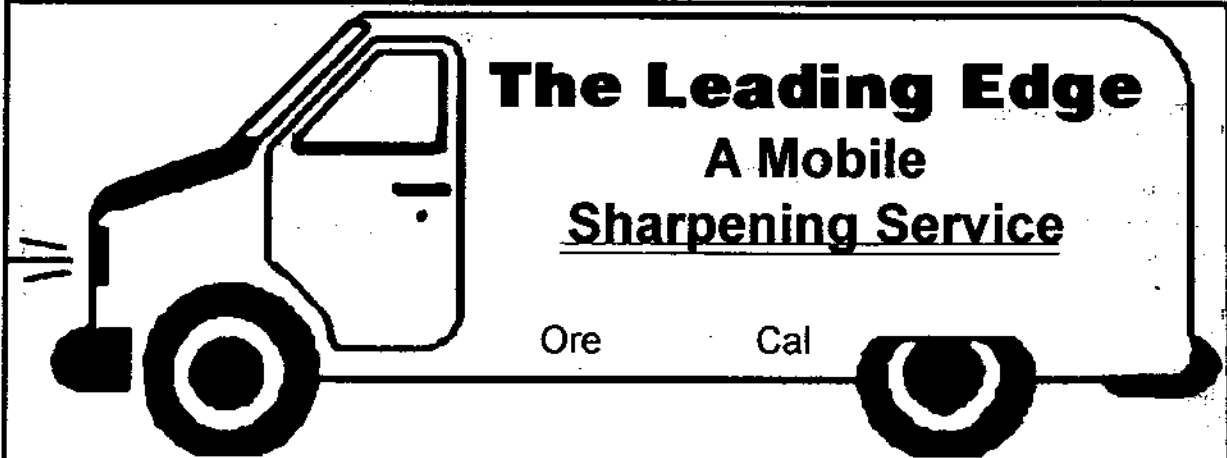
