## The World On Fire by Evan Kramer

Summer arrived with a vengeance this Tuesday. The day was extremely warm with temperatures ranging from the 80's into the 90's along the southern Oregon coast. It felt like the ultimate summer day. I started the morning by wandering around my yard for a while. I heard an unusual sound coming out of a wooded area and went to see what kind of bird was causing such a ruckus. It wasn't a bird at all. It was one noisy squirrel. The first one I've seen in our neighborhood in 3 1/2 years.

As of 1:00pm Wednesday afternoon Port Orford remained unscathed by the many fires burning in Curry County including

a major one at Coy Creek, located between Port Orford and Gold Beach. A fire on Cape Blanco road on Tuesday afternoon was handily put out by the Sixes Fire Department. On Wednesday morning at 8:20am a crew from Port Orford headed south as part of the mutual aid network.

Meanwhile it seems like almost all of Southern California is in flames. Fires are raging out of control from Pt. Mugu to San Diego. The fires are threatening the wild animal park near San Diego. Over 100 homes have already been destroyed. Sometimes it seems like if it's not one thing it's another.

A few weeks back we talked about all the new businesses starting up in town and others moving from one location to another. This weekend a couple of these enterprises are having open houses. The Ace of Gems jewelry, antique and gifts store located at 351 West 6th St. is having its grand opening this weekend on

Saturday and Sunday from 10:00am - 8:00pm. Their store is right next door to the Breezin' Hair Care salon. I am impressed with what they've done to the outside of their older building and am looking forward to seeing the inside. The other grand opening is for Mary Loan and Teresa Engdahl who have moved from their former offices into a house they have remodeled into an office. It is located on 526 W. 9th Street. Their open house coincides with Halloween weekend and takes place on Friday afternoon, October 29. Mary told me she'd be wearing a costume but for guests it's optional.

Speaking of Halloween which falls on Sunday this year it also coincides with the first day of Pacific Standard time. Remember to turn back your clocks on Saturday night and you'll gain back that hour you lost last spring. Even the moon

Trick Or Treat

This Sunday is Halloween. Little children will put on their costumes and go trick or treating. They will be greeted at the door with candy. Nine short days after Halloween, the state of Oregon will come trick-or-treating asking you to vote on Measure 1. This statewide ballot initiative places the issue of a sales tax before the voters for the 9th time.

The proposed 5% sales tax is a complicated issue. It would add a tax on many consumer goods while delivering property tax relief in the form of eliminated school property tax on owner occupied single family homes.

I'm voting no on this attempt to add another layer of taxation to this state. The reasons are many including the fact that this tax is a split roll tax like Measure 7 which the voters crushed at the polls last November. Business property and rental property don't receive the benefits of Measure 1. They should have entitled this ballot initiative "No Relief For Renters" who make up 30% of the population of the state.

Business owners like myself and the

thousands of other small businesspeople are going to gain a new partner if Measure 1 passes - the State of Oregon. We would have to collect the 5% tax for them, keep records, etc. No Thanks!

An argument I constantly hear in favor of the sales tax is that the "tourists will pay their share". They do pay their share when they come to Oregon and stay in motels, eat in restaurants and buy gas, groceries and souvenirs. If measure 1 passes they'll have 5% less spendable income.

Also, Oregon is bordered by the heavy sales tax states of Washington and California. Places like Brookings and

Portland see a huge influx in people from these states doing their shopping here. Why? Because they've had it with the punitive sales tax levels in their own states. Face it, Oregon is an attractive place to buy your consumer goods.

One last thing. People like myself who vote against Measure 1 are not anti school or student. The fact is that although the sales tax money will go to the schools, an equal amount now being given to schools from the general fund will probably be withheld and used for other boondoggles. The schools may never see an extra penny!

Measure 1 is a treat for the politicians, but a dirty trick for the rest of us!

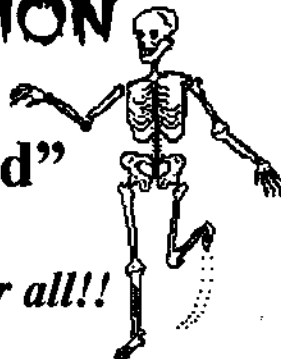

"The Ghost Ship Oliver Olson" is the theme of the Halloween Haunted House to be sponsored by the Bandon Lions Club on October 29, 30, 31. The event will open from 7:00-10:00pm each evening in The Barn at City Park, located at the end of 11th Street West in Bandon.

The S.S. Oliver Olson was a coastal freighter built by the Albin Iron Works in Portland in 1918. She was 289 feet long with a beam of 44 feet, and was 2,225 gross tons in size.

Captain Carl L. Hubner and his crew were bound for the Port of Bandon on the

fateful day of Nov. 3, 1953. As the ship approached Bandon she was driven toward the South Jetty by strong southerly swells and foundered on the rocks.

Crew members were rescued by breeches buoy from the ship to the jetty and the Olson was cut down to the waterline for salvage. For many years the remains of the hull could be seen on the jetty at low tide.

The Haunted House will re-create the hapless vessel and the ghosts of crew members will roam through the various parts of the ship.

The Lions will be assisted by the Bandon Lioness Club. The Bandon-By-The-Sea Kiwanis Club will hold a chili cook-off in conjunction with the project and the Veterans of Foreign Post 3440 will conduct hay rides from towns out to the Barn.

Prices are \$3.50 for adults and \$2.50 for kids to 12 years. Repeat trips through the ship are \$1. Proceed will be used by the Lions for their sight and hearing projects. For further information, call Chairman Dan Almich at 347-2517.

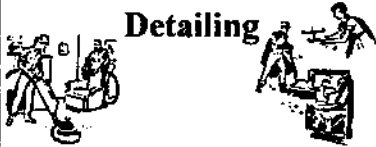

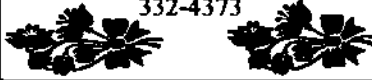

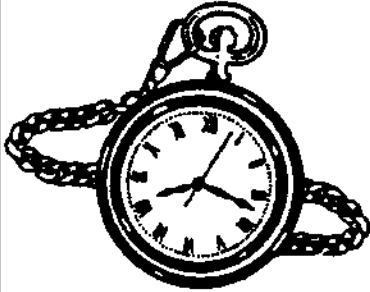

Look for this bright golden yellow star twinkling very low in WNW about 45 minutes after sunset. It sets quickly and is below the horizon for most of the night, but can be seen again 45 minutes before sunrise, very low in ENE, some 30° left of brilliant Venus.

**Sat. Oct. 30** - The moon was Full at 8:38 a.m. EDT this morning. This Full Moon after the Harvest Moon of September 30th is known as the Hunter's Moon. With the fields harvested and cleared, hunters now have an easier time spotting their quarry.
