

## Tuna Jam '94 by Evan Kramer

The Port Orford Arts Council and the Port Orford Fishermen's Association are sponsoring the first ever Tuna Jam at the Dock at the Port of Port Orford. This community event takes place this Saturday, September 10, starting at noon and continuing on through the afternoon. I've had a few questions directed to me about what a Tuna Jam is exactly and, no, you won't find it for sale at Gwendolyn's Jam Stand. "Tuna" refers to what the two groups are serving. Barbecued fresh albacore tuna which will be prepared and served in the immediate vicinity of the Dock Tackle store along with a side order of potato salad - all for \$5.00. Or you can get a piece of albacore tuna on a stick for \$1.00. Soda and coffee will be available at Dock Tackle. While you're down at The Dock you may even see a grey whale.

"Jam" refers to the music which will consist of a group of drummers and musicians including Colin and Christine Courtney. You're welcome to join in making the music. Just bring your drums or other musical instruments. The more the merrier. One of the additional features of the Tuna Jam will be an anchor throw put on by the Fishermen's Association. Wonder if it will be the anchor from the Amak? Actually, I heard it will be a 15 pound anchor. The fishermen will also put on a survival suit demonstration. Now if it gets real hot Saturday we can call this event the "Tuna Melt."

The event is part fund-raiser and part membership drive for the Arts Council. There is already talk of an Arts Festival event at the Port next year.

They will be accepted through the October 27 edition of this paper.

The Nob Hill Salon Orchestra, a group of five musicians from San Francisco, will appear at Harbor Hall in Bandon on Friday, September 16, at 8:00pm. Their performance is sponsored by the Coquille Performing Arts Council, but has been moved to Bandon due to the fire at the Sawdust Theater.

The musicians play violin, viola, cello and piano.

The musicians are John Tenney, who is the first violinist and narrator for the group, James Shallenberger playing second violin, who is a founding member of the Kronos String Quartet; Wieslaw Porgorzelski playing viola and formerly with the Warsaw Philharmonic; Kelley Boyer playing cello who is currently with the Santa Rosa Symphony and Richard Riccardi on piano who was the assistant conductor on the touring company of "Annie".

The program, entitled "American Tunesmiths," focuses on the New York-based melody makers of Tin Pan Alley. Musical selections range from sentimental ballads and ragtime of the 1890's to the songs of Gershwin and Berlin in the 1940's. The audience will recognize such favorites as "When The Red, Red Robin Goes Bob, Bob, Bobbin Along," "Tiger Rag," "I Got Rhythm," and "Ain't She Sweet."


