Letter To The Editor,


The city of Port Orford has been incorporated since 1935, and now it seems, it is in vogue that city officials should have a city credit card.

D&J Texaco Minimart To Donate Coffee Proceeds To Hospital

Put your caffeine habit to work to help "Fill Curry's Heart." From now through the end of Curry General Hospital's \$100,000 fund-raiser, a quarter will be set aside for the hospital for every medium or large coffee purchased at D&J Texaco Minimart in Gold Beach.

The fund-raiser kicked off May 1 and will end Nov. 1, 1994.

Coffee contributions, made possible in part with help from Endert Distributing of Crescent City, are "one way we could help be a part of the fund-raiser," Jim Turner, Texaco owner, said. "We didn't want to be left out."

Datascope monitoring system.







Temporary Plant Closure

Pacific Premium Seafoods announced they were curtailing operations for a temporary period of up to sixty days. A spokesman for the company said that unstable product quality had resulted in poor foreign sales and that the company had cut back operations until the quality of harvested material improves. This sort of closure has been done before and is a normal part of the business.

The company expects to re-open no later than November 15 but could re-open as early as next week. Although product from other nearby areas remains poor, a test of the local reef showed the quality there to be good. Test marketing of a sample from the local reef is currently being done in Japan.

Although harvesting the local reef is legal at this time, the co-op members have a gentlemen's agreement to refrain from harvesting it until November 1. Non-members have been reported to be harvesting the reef since last week and this may force an early end to the voluntary closure.


