**School District In The News**

## **2CJ School News** by Valerie Jean Kramer

At the monthly board meeting last week, board members approved an attempt to get a grant to provide health services to the children in the form of a full time nurse, a part time health professional, and clerical support. This improvement is possible now because the recent re-assignment of the fourth grade to the middle school has made space for health rooms on all campuses as required by law. We believe that our district has a great need for this service and a good chance of securing the grant.

The board authorized the business manager to arrange a short-term loan to meet the school payroll and other expenses. In the past few years, we have carried enough money over from one year to the next to avoid the expense of borrowing but this year we had less money to carry forward. The district must meet expenses and payroll that begin with the new school year but the state does not distribute tax moneys to the district until some time in October. Late-breaking good news! I was just informed that the state funds came through just in time and that we didn't have to apply for the loan at this time!

The contract negotiations between the district and the teachers' union have stalled and are entering mediation. The district is in the third of a three year contract and the only matter being negotiated is compensation.

The board voted to adopt the goals shown below. (I've had to edit them a bit to condense them for publication.) I think we have a really great set of goals this year and I hope we can see progress made in each of these areas.

Subsequent to the board meeting, the board received notice that the arbitrator has found in favor of teacher Ray Davis and has ordered him reinstated in the district.

The board will have a workshop session on Wednesday, October 26 at 7pm at Pacific High School. This session will include a short board meeting regarding employment of staff and PERS. The next regular board meeting will be a week later than normal on Tuesday, November 15 at 8:00pm with a closed executive session at 7:00pm. The Driftwood booster club will meet at 3:00pm Oct. 26 in the school library.

The robotics and industrial arts students are working cooperatively in a new combined technology class. Their project this semester is a working remote-controlled miniature (about 5-6' long) submarine with camera.

### **1994-95 Board Goals**

Assure that the district's public schools produce citizens who have the essential skills and knowledge to be successful. Expectations for students in the schools must become more rigorous. Parents and students must give school work a higher

priority. To this end we should:

Design and implement instructional strategies which require higher productivity from our students.

Write a K-12 homework policy.

Identify CIM and CAM requirements which address productivity.

Examine Health and P.E. curriculums to determine K-12 continuity program.

Identify barriers to parent involvement. Tell parents what they are expected to contribute toward their children's education. Design and implement strategies which require more standard parent accountability for each student learning. Provide increased support to parents to help them encourage their children in school experiences.

Explore areas of assistance needed with the building site councils. Ask staff and parents what they need in order to be more involved.

Identify and support those students who are not developing to their potential we should assemble a team to:

Determine what we now have in place and identify areas of void then prepare a plan that will provide support to promote student development and improve the school district program in building self esteem.

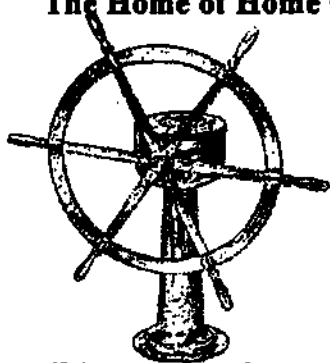

The Hubbard Creek/Garrison Lake Watershed Management Council met on Wednesday, Oct. 12. Public meetings are held at 7pm on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month in the Port Orford City Hall council chambers.

Council member Frank Smith, vice-chairman of the South Coast Coordinating Watershed Council, gave a report on the Coordinating Council's October meeting. Secretary Ellen Warring, had prepared a letter for the Coordinating Council which included a complete list of Port Orford council members, addressed tak-

ing on the entire Hubbard Creek basin, agreed to open up its membership to groups not currently represented and defined the City of Port Orford's role with the watershed council. Smith submitted this information to the county group. We have now been recognized by the County group and have turned in our first project for both technical assistance and funding. This project is the one developed by council members John Mayea and Justin

Bauman with help from Hans Von Spaeth on the placement of weirs in front of culverts along creeks and wetlands feeding into Garrison Lake. Garrison Lake is the largest lake in the State of Oregon within a city. It is the secondary source of water for the City of Port Orford. From December, 1993 to June, 1994 it was the primary source of water for the city due to unacceptable turbidity levels in the water entering the city reservoir on the north fork of Hubbard Creek.

Smith told the council we need to develop a watershed assessment and form an action plan for both the entire Hubbard Creek basin and Garrison Lake watershed. The council decided to form two subcommittees. One will work on the assessment for Hubbard Creek and the other for Garrison Lake.

Ellen Warring spoke about developing a professional wetlands assessment. There may be grant money available to hire a wetlands delineator and develop an inventory of the wetlands in both watersheds. The council discussed developing an education program for the public and gave it a high priority.

The next meeting is 7pm Wed., Oct. 26, at Port Orford City Hall.

**National Head Start Month**
