Voters Say No To JP Courts Republican Landslide By Evan Kramer

Tuesday, November 8, 1994. Mark your calendars. History was made as the Republican Party captured control of the United States Senate and the House of Representatives. The Republicans have not controlled the House of Representatives for 40 years! The last Republican Speaker of the House was John Martin. Republicans controlled the Senate for the first six years of the Reagan Presidency and have regained control of that house.

Curry County voters wanted nothing to do with the two serial levies on Tuesday's ballot. They overwhelmingly rejected a 5 year serial levy to fund the two Justice of the Peace courts at a cost of \$109,000 a year. Barring any unforeseen happenings both courts will cease to function as of January 1, 1995. The three year sheriff's department serial levy for \$2,300,000 also suffered a nearly 2 - 1 defeat.

Locally, incumbent Port Orford city council member Martha Weaver-Britell swept to a victory over challenger David Elsdon with a 2-1 advantage. Tim Sparks, Carl Eskelson and Robert Warring were also elected to the Port Orford City Council. All three ran unopposed.

The voters chose Republican T.V. Skinner over Democrat Marilyn Schafer in the

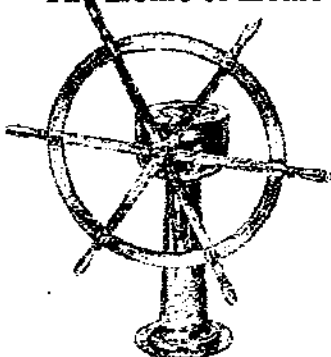
Knock Out The Flu

Curry General Hospital News

Total emergency room visits at Curry General Hospital in September this year jumped more than 25% compared to the same period a year ago, according to the hospital's most recent census report. September 1994 emergency room visits totaled 259, compared to 195 in September 1993.

"Better weather and more people out enjoying Curry County" could be two reasons for the jump, Nancy Hooker, director of nursing, surmised. "Although we had a lot of patients come in with abdominal pains," she added.

Also in September this year, gross patient revenues totaled \$322,149 compared to \$250,625 during the same period the previous year.

Physicians at Curry General performed 15 outpatient and emergency surgeries in September 1994, compared to 13 in September 1993.

A total of eight babies were born in the hospital during September this year, the same number born during September 1993.

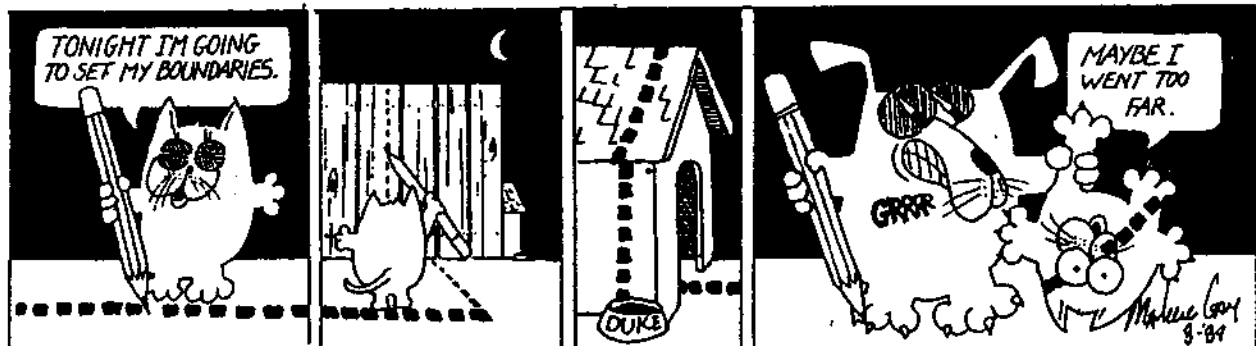

Lost At Sea by Sandi Eisman

Last Sunday night the town of Port Orford experienced the worst nightmare of a fishing community - one of the boats did not show up at the end of the day.

One of five or six boats trolling for spawner salmon in the ocean near the mouth of the Elk River, Tim O'Hearn called our boat, Casey III, on the radio and said, "Hey, Bill, I just got two out of five salmon here. Bill came back, "all right! Where are you?" "I'm right in front of you!" Tim said. We looked to the south and saw his boat in front of Clouqueh Rock. We caught a couple of salmon and

then as we started to put the lines in the boat to go home just before dark we saw Tim directly west and not even a mile away from the Port. We went on in and sold our fish assuming that Tim had gone in ahead of us and was at home.

Around 7:00 pm Chris called us from the fish buying station on the dock and asked if we'd seen Tim before we came in. We realized immediately that something was wrong - he should be in. The nightmare had begun.

We joined some other fishermen at the dock as Chris called the Coast Guard to send a helicopter and some one drove up on the hill to look for lights. Other people

started for the beaches with 4-wheelers to look for signs of Tim.

There was a huge swell and rough ocean. He would be hard to see. Fishermen began launching their boats to search. Our biggest hope was for the immediate assistance of the Coast Guard helicopter with its powerful lights and fast coverage of the area.

It took over an hour and three desperate phone calls, before the Coast Guard responded. The helicopter had been flying over us that day watching us fish but they didn't seem to want to come down in the dark and cold to assist boaters in distress.

They finally sent the chopper at the tearful pleading of Tim's wife, Merline. Meanwhile thanks to the quick and efficient response of the fishermen and townspeople Tim's boat was spotted at around 11:00 pm near Island Rock a few miles south of the Port.

Two fishermen jumped on the boat from the fishing vessel Aries and found Tim unconscious after a fall that injured his spine and paralyzed him. The boat was brought in and the ambulance met him at the dock. He was flown to Eugene to the hospital where he was operated on for a herniated disk in his neck.

Our prayers are with Tim and Merline as we wait to see how he recovers. This harrowing experience brought everyone involved closer and has reminded us not to take anything or anyone for granted
