NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

Due to increased rules and regulations and a very high tide on the night of July 4th, the following closures will be in effect:

The beach from Battle Rock to Hubbard Creek will be closed to ALL VEHICLE TRAFFIC—ALL DAY. Exception: Vehicles necessary for the dinghy races.

The beach from Battle Rock south to the big rock (known locally as Cabbage Rock) in the middle of the beach (marked with barricade tape) will be completely closed to the public at 3:00 pm. on July 4th. It will not reopen until after the fireworks display is over and the Fire Department has left the beach. These closures will ensure the safety of the public and the fire department personnel. These closures will be strictly enforced. No personal fireworks will be permitted on the beach.
